

- Subcommittee of Santa Clara Basin Watershed Management Initiative (WMI)
- Formed in 2010 with representatives from cities, counties, and transportation agencies
- ZLI Mission combat the multi-faceted litter problem by bringing stakeholders together to identify collaborative solutions
- Previously conducted roundtables on the water quality impacts of homelessness and litter associated with garbage/recycling collection
- First webinar (*The Nexus Between Solid Waste and Stormwater Management*) in October 2016
- Second webinar (Reducing the Impacts of Smoking on Stormwater Quality) in January 2018

## Impetus for Webinars




- Trash impacts many San Francisco Bay Area creeks and shorelines
- Plastic straws are one of the most frequently observed items in local waterways
- Plastic straws are not recyclable
- Bay Area (and nearly all other California) municipalities are required to significantly reduce trash
- Reducing plastic litter can assist municipalities in achieving these goals
